1. **Increase Academic Progress:** *applies to every student, all of our students are making progress towards graduation with 2 credits per week, being ahead plus graduating early, committing to appt times, outside HW goals, students should plan for 10 hrs to complete each core credit; Parental feedback: smaller group instruction; Solution: started a Math SGI with Ms.Trinh, Alg 1 math seminar completed not too long ago, finished an entire year of Alg 1 within 4 months excluding breaks, now focused on Geometry SGI*
2. **Increase Student Attendance:** *attend in-person/online, minors required in-person 2xs on-site/online, adults required 1x on-site/online per week, attendance DOES NOT count until a given window, attendance tied to student work*
